 - A.* Conversion From a One-Map Based Planning System to a Two-Map Based Planning System Chad Giesinger, AICP, Senior Planner, Department of Community Development will discuss the conversion of the county's current planning system which relies on one map to represent both the master plan and zoning to a system that utilizes a separate master plan and zoning maps. Mr. Giesinger will discuss the reasons for the transition, provide some details on how the new system would function, and answer any questions. (This item is informational only and no action will be taken.)
 - B. Amendment of Conditions Case No. AC09-007 (Sierra Nevada Teen Ranch) Review and recommendations on the request to amend condition #7 of the Special Use Permit case number SB07-019 to extend the time for completion of each phase of the project by two additional years from the original date of approval by the Washoe County Commission such that phase one will be extended to February 12, 2012, phase two will be extended to February 12, 2014, phase three will be extended to February 12, 2016 and phase four will be extended to February 12, 2019 as authorized in Section 110.810 of the Washoe County Development Code. The Sierra Nevada Teen Ranch is a teen group care facility that will include housing, counseling, education and recreational opportunities for up to 40 at-risk teenagers. The project is located in Bedell Flat, east of the Sierra Ranchos/Rancho Haven communities. The 29-acre parcel is designated General Rural (GR) in the North Valleys Area Plan, and is situated in a portion of Section 4, T23N, R19E, MDM, Washoe County, Nevada. The property is located in the North Valleys Citizen Advisory Board boundary and Washoe County Commission District No. 5. (APN: 079-210-15).  - C. Reno Fire Station #15 Ladder Truck The Reno Fire Station #15 is located in Sun Valley. Having this fire station house a ladder truck is important to the North Valleys CAB because the ladder truck could be called into service in the North Valleys area. The CAB may ask the recording secretary to draft a memorandum to Commissioners Kitty Jung and Bonnie Weber expressing the community's desire to have the Reno Fire Station #15 house a ladder truck.
