Those items marked with an asterisk (\*) may be discussed but action will not be taken on them.

**Possible changes to the agenda order and timing.** Discussion may be delayed on any item on this agenda, and items on this agenda may be taken out of order, combined with other items and discussed or voted on as a block, removed from the agenda, moved to the agenda of another later meeting, and/or moved to or from the consent section. Items designated for a specified time will not be heard before that time, but may be delayed beyond the specified time.

Public Comment; disrupting of meeting. During the "Public Comment" periods listed below, anyone may speak pertaining to any matter either on or off the agenda. Comments are to be directed to the CAB as a whole and not to one individual. The presiding officer may (with or without advance warning) order the removal of a person whose conduct willfully disrupts the meeting to the extent that its orderly conduct is made impractical.

  - A.\* Update on the Proposed Washoe County Commission Redistricting Map Commissioner Weber will provide an update regarding the Proposed Washoe County Commission Redistricting Map that will be discussed, and possibly adopted, at the January 10, 2012 Washoe County Commission meeting. Ms. Weber will also discuss possibly realigning the CAB Geographic Boundaries to more closely conform to the new Redistricting Map, when adopted.

- A.\* Update on Review Process and Possible Alternatives for NV Energy's Bordertown to California Transmission Line Project Marnie Bonesteel, Humboldt Toiyabe National Forest, and Nancy Kang, JBR Environmental Consultants, will provide an update on the environmental review process and alternatives being considered for NV Energy's Bordertown to California 120 kV transmission line project. NV Energy proposes to construct a 10-mile transmission line between the Bordertown substation, near Bordertown, and the California Substation, near Verdi, that would run generally along the Nevada side of the Nevada/California border. The US Forest Service is starting to prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) that will take about 2 years to complete. Ms. Bonesteel and Ms. Kang are seeking input from the CAB members and citizens and will respond to questions following the presentation.
