






NDOT Tahoe Project

- Installation of ITS conduit on SR-28
- Installing new guardrail on SR-28
- Soil stabilization along SR-28 north of Memorial Point
- Installing new curb and gutter on SR-28 to help preserve the roadway
- Crystal Bay sidewalk reconstruction & repaving






• Bicycle/Pedestrian Connection between Crystal Bay and Incline Village

- Multiuse path connection between Crystal Bay and Incline Village identified






State Route 28 National Scenic Byway Corridor Management Plan

America's Most Beautrful Drive






Anticipated Alignment Alternatives (based on past work)

- Shared geometry within SR 28 (north side)
- Potential switchbacks and deviations from SR-28

Potential Criteria (from Stateline-Stateline study)

- Environmental Constraints Scenic, Biological, Cultural, Hydrology, Tree Removal
- Cost/Constructability Grading, Property Impacts, Grade Separation Needs, Length, Maintenance, Structure Needs
- User Experience Bikeway Vision, Safety, Community Connections, Interpretive Opportunities, Scenic Opportunities, User Friendliness

Next Step: Identify funding for preliminary engineering and environmental studies, potential for federal grants

- Very positive community feedback
