 - A.* Lazy 5 Regional Park Update Al Rogers, Assistant Director for Regional Parks and Open Space (RPOS), will present an update on Lazy 5 programming and facilities. (This item is informational only and no action will be taken.)

10. OLD BUSINESS

A. Request from Washoe County Public Works for CAB Input for Potential Pedestrian and Bike Projects – Final review and recommendations on the Washoe County request from the CABs to develop a list of potential pedestrian and bicycle projects to be located within public right-of-way of County maintained public streets. Washoe County has the opportunity to apply for Transportation Equity Act (TEA) enhancement funds later this year. Projects for this funding source are transportation related and not recreational. As TEA enhancement

project funding is limited to \$650,000 per project, a relatively small amount for construction, it is recommended that projects be segmented in sections of ½ mile (2640 feet). In the past, Washoe County has been granted one project on a 2-year funding cycle. Although County staff will not be at the CAB meeting, questions can be directed to Clara Lawson, P.E., P.T.O.E., with Washoe County Public Works, by emailing her at Clawson@washoecounty.us or calling her at 775.328.3603. Currently, the SSCAB has one previously recommended pedestrian and bike path project on Highand Ranch (Bike Route). During the July CAB meeting, the CAB discussed possible areas for future pedestrian and bike paths. During this CAB meeting, the CAB may take action on this topic to recommend either (A.) the top three community ranked priority pedestrian and bike path projects or (B.) forward all suggested projects for consideration.

- B. Pedestrian Access Update on the progress of organizing the project to install safe pedestrian access to (a) Eagle Landing shopping center and (b) Lazy 5 Regional Park. Following the update and possible discussion, the CAB may forward comments, concerns, and/or recommendations to the Washoe County Commission.
- C. Intersection of Calle de la Plata and Pyramid Highway The Spanish Springs CAB will continue discussions on various options and may provide recommendations to the Washoe County Commission expressing the CAB's and community's interest to have the intersection of Calle de la Plata and Pyramid Highway improved. The report may include information from Susan Martinovich, Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) and from the consortium of developers regarding plans for the intersection.
