- 5. **RECOGNITION** The Spanish Springs CAB will publicly recognize and thank the Nevada Department of Transportation and Mike Fuess, District Traffic Engineer, for their efforts in facilitating the installation of barrier blinders on Pyramid Lake Highway. The addition of barrier blinders greatly increased public safety by reducing eye strain for drivers on this critical roadway in Spanish Springs.
- 6. PUBLIC COMMENT: Comment heard under this item will be limited to items not on this agenda and will also be limited to three minutes per person. Public comment and/or testimony, as applicable, will also be allowed under each individual agenda item and will likewise be subject to the same three minute limitation per speaker.
