Project Description:

- This study will help in understanding the driving performance of adults and how their perception is different from actual driving performance. We will ask you to complete a survey designed to assess self-rated driving behavior, demographics (e.g., age, gender, race/ethnicity, education level), and non-sensitive medical history information. The research team will also conduct an interview with you. After the data collection, the research team will integrate all the data to identify the correlations between physical and psychological measures related to driving performance and its impact on driving efficacy and safety. Your identification will not be shared with anyone except the research team. This is a collaborative research with the University of Nevada Reno and University of Texas, Arlington.
