Master Plan Amendment Case Number MPA15-005 and Regulatory Zone Amendment Case Number RZA15-008 (Ridges at Hunter Creek) Request for community discussion and feedback on a proposed Master Plan Amendment and Regulatory Zone Map change that will result in a potential increase of 32 lots throughout 154.99 acres located south of Woodchuck Circle and Hunters Peak road and West of Hawken Drive. The Master Plan amendment is a request to change a master plan category form a mix of rural and suburban residential to rural, rural residential and suburban residential. The Regulatory Zone Amendment is to amend the Southwest Truckee Meadows Regulatory Zone Map to change the regulatory zone from mix of general rural and low density suburban to 69.95 acres of general rural, 59.2 acres of high density rural and 26.1 acres of low density suburban.
