Traffic in Numbers

- 66% INCREASE at Garson I-80 East On-Ramp
 - 2018 1,450 Average Daily Trips (ADT's)/2021 2,400
- 39% INCREASE at Garson I-80 West Off-ramp
 - 2018 1,900/2021 *-* 2,650
- 17% INCREASE at Bridge Street (near Railroad Tracks)
- 2018 640/2021 750
- 68% INCREASE at South Verdi Road/Bridge Street terminus
- 2015 250/2021 420
- 59% INCREASE on Crystal Park Road (near Gavina Ln)
- 2018 220/2021 350
- 29% INCREASE on Highway 40 (SR425) between River Oaks and West Meadows
- 2015 3,400/2021 4,400



Permit Loads!

 Permit Loads - Loads that are too large to fit underneath the overpasses built in the 60's. These extra large loads exit I-80 East near Gold Ranch, take Highway 40 to Bridge Street, South Verdi Road to Garson Road and enter I-80 East via the Garson on-ramp
