

# Open Space and Regional Parks Commission Meeting September 2024

#### **SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS**

- Galena Creek Regional Parks campfire programs Star Gazing with the Astronomical Society of Nevada was postponed on August 2<sup>nd</sup>. It is tentatively rescheduled for September 28th
- 3<sup>rd</sup> annual "Regional Junior Ranger Day" was hosted on Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup> at Washoe Lake State Park, with Park Rangers from Washoe County, Nevada State Parks, City of Reno and Carson City.
- The Davis Fire started on September 7<sup>th</sup> in Davis Creek Regional Park and burned over 5,800 acres but fortunately spared most of the land within the park and Galena Creek Regional Park was mostly untouched due to the efforts of the fire crews.
