## YEAR END SUMMARY

There was a total of 9,788.75 volunteer hours reported in 2024, an increase of almost 1,400 since 2023. The estimated national value of volunteer time is currently \$33.49 per hour, equaling a total annual value of \$327,825. This total volunteer time is also equivalent to having almost 5 additional full-time staff.
