ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2025-05

Pursuant to NRS 4.157(c) and JCRRT 21, the Chief Justice of the Peace of Reno Township enters this Administrative Order regarding the Washoe County Department of Alternative Sentencing (“DAS”). Reno Justice Court has relied upon DAS to supervise Reno Justice Court defendants who have been released from custody pending trial. Similarly, defendants who are on misdemeanor probation and/or are participating in one of this Court’s treatment court programs are also supervised by DAS. The services offered by DAS include, among other things, drug and alcohol testing at DAS’s Sober 24 testing facility.

Earlier this year, the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners repealed the enabling ordinance that created DAS. December 31, 2025 is the final day of operations for DAS and the Sober 24 testing facility. Accordingly, this Court hereby orders as follows:

- 1) Any Reno Justice Court defendant who is currently under an order to submit to drug and alcohol testing at the Sober 24 facility is hereby relieved of that condition subject to the limitations set forth paragraphs 2-4 below.
- 2) Any Reno Justice Court pretrial defendant who has a pending felony or gross misdemeanor case and is currently supervised by DAS shall have their pretrial


1 supervision immediately transferred to the Pre-Trial Services Division of the Second
2 Judicial District Court, according to the conditions of release set forth in the
3 individual defendant's Judicial Release Order. If any such defendant is required to
4 submit to drug and alcohol testing at the Sober 24 facility, that testing shall continue
5 under the management of Pre-Trial Services at the facility of their choosing.

6 3) Any Reno Justice Court pretrial defendant who has a pending misdemeanor case in
7 Reno Justice Court and is currently supervised by DAS shall have their pretrial
8 supervision immediately transferred to Reno Justice Court. If any such defendant is
9 required to submit to drug and alcohol testing as a condition of their pretrial release,
10 that condition is hereby revoked until further order of this Court. All other conditions
11 set forth in a misdemeanor defendant's Judicial Release Order shall remain in full
12 effect.

13 4) Any Reno Justice Court defendant who is supervised by DAS because they are on
14 misdemeanor probation and/or participating in one of this Court's treatment court
15 programs shall have their supervision transferred to the Washoe County Sheriff
16 Office's Alternative Sentencing Unit. Any necessary drug and alcohol testing for
17 these defendants shall be managed by the Alternative Sentencing Unit in the manner
18 it sees fit, unless otherwise ordered by this Court.
