Through the CSFP, the Food Bank of Northern Nevada provides ONE BOX of nutritious food to lowincome seniors monthly. Never Send Money

to someone you have never met face-to-face.

Take precautions when making online purchases. Don't shop on price

alone. Scammers offer hard-to-find products at great prices.

Don't but online unless the transaction is secure. Make sure the website has "https" in the URL (the extra "s" id for "secure") and a small lock icon on the address bar. Even then, the site could be shady. Research the company first at BBB.org.

Avoid making quick purchases while browsing social media. Scammers advertise websites that offer great deals, but don't deliver the product at all or deliver counterfeit products.

Do more research on those products you found via online search.

10 General Tips for AVOIDING A SCAM

Don't click on links or open attachments in unsolicited email or

text messages.

Be extremely cautious when dealing with anyone you've met

online.

Never share personally identifiable information

with someone who has contacted you unsolicited.

Don't be

pressured to act immediately.

Use secure, traceable transactions

when making payments for goods, services, taxes, and debts.

Don't believe everything you see or read.

Scammers are great at mimicking official seals, fonts, and other details. Just because a website or email looks official does not mean it is. Even Caller ID can be faked.

Whenever possible, work with businesses that have

proper identification licensing, and insurance.

Be cautious about

what you share on social media.
