Food Bank Truck (Commodity Supplemental Food Program)

Through the CSFP, the Food Bank of Northern Nevada provides ONE BOX of nutritious food to lowincome seniors monthly. Gross monthly income limits: \$1,473 (one person) \$1,984 (two people) Sign up at distribution. ID required. Every third Tuesday of the month, the Assistance League supplies seniors with TWO BAGS of groceries with essentials.
