STAKEHOLDER REVIEW(s)

Stakeholder is a primary Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) – City of Reno Public Safety Dispatch.

PREVIOUS ACTION & BACKGROUND

On October 9, 2025, the Washoe County E911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee approved Sparks Police Department PSAP reimbursement of the costs associated with renewing 2026 NENA and APCO membership fees for a total of \$3,511.00.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Enhanced 911 Fund is a special revenue fund which receives revenue pursuant to NRS 244A.7643 in the form of telephone surcharges collected to support the emergency reporting system.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the E911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee approve the request to reimburse the costs associated with renewing NENA annual memberships for 2026, not to exceed \$3,200.00.
